The ZAP Program is still in the process of finalizing many of the Tier II contracts. If you haven't signed your contract, please call me immediately! As the contracts are fully executed, we are able to submit requests for the first payment of the Tier II contract. The first payment will be 60% of the contract amount. The final payment will be sent in mid-April 2008. Most organizations should receive their first payment by the end of November or the first part of December 2007. Changes to ZAP Website

The Zoo, Arts and Parks Program is pleased to announce improvements to our website. Hopefully within the next month or two you will see some changes that help ZAP recipients and the public navigate through our site. 2008 Funding Reminder:

Beginning, January of 2008, food will no longer be charged a sales tax. This means the amount of sales tax revenues collected for 1/10 of 1% Zoo, Arts & Parks will be less in 2008 than in 2007. The Salt Lake County Auditor's office is projecting a 5% cut over 2007 projections, which would total \$20,540,000 for all the ZAP revenue collected in 2008. This means approximately \$1,820,871 for Tier II, \$9,888,341 for Tier I and \$2,453,118 for Zoological organizations. If the economy continues to grow, 2008 ZAP revenues may even be the same as 2007 funding.
